Aware IM Concepts

The following section describes how to use **Aware IM** to configure and operate applications that manage business information. The section is divided into several parts. The first part identifies the main generic aspects of essentially any information management application, describes how these generic aspects can be implemented in **Aware IM** and the specifics of the **Aware IM** approach to this implementation. The second part identifies other features that most applications are likely to require and describes how they can be implemented in **Aware IM**. Finally the last part provides an overview of the configuration process and lists the productivity features of the **Aware IM** Configuration Tool that help configurators create flexible and powerful applications.
