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How to upload an image from camera or photo library of the phone

One approach is to define an attribute of the Picture type for one of your forms. **AwareIM** will automatically generate controls to upload the image from a camera or photo library. This approach will work in both browser-based mobile applications and native mobile applications.

Another approach is to use the [MOBILE CAMERA SNAP INTO](#) action in some process (or [MOBILE CAMERA GET INTO](#) action to get access to photo library). When AwareIM executes this action the user will be able to upload a photo from camera or a photo library. The image will be written into the picture attribute specified in the action. For example:

```
MOBILE CAMERA SNAP INTO MyObject.MyPictureAttribute
```

note

These actions will only work for native mobile applications – they will not work inside the mobile browser. Please see [Mobile Applications](#) and [Rule Language Guide](#) for more details about these actions.
